VEAM 2026 Special Issue

In the second half of 2027, the *Revue d'économie du développement* will publish a special issue containing a **selection of papers drawn from accepted contributions to the 17th Vietnam Economists Annual Meeting (VEAM 2026)** to be held at University of Economics, Hue University on 14 and 15 July 2026.

Submitting articles

- Online submission: <https://red.manuscriptmanager.net/> from 14 July to 30 September 2026.
- The manuscript must be accepted for presentation at VEAM 2026
- The manuscript must be original; it must not have been previously published in any form, nor simultaneously submitted to another journal for publication.
- The article must be written in English or French.
- The article must be exceed **10,000 words**, including abstracts, tables, graphs, notes, and references.
- On the first page, below the title, authors must provide:
 - ✓ The author's name, position, and professional address;
 - ✓ An abstract in French and in English (include translation of article title), each of which should be no longer than 150 words;
 - ✓ A list of keywords (maximum of 5) describing the article's contents;
 - ✓ JEL codes (Journal of Economic Literature classification system).

Presentation

- The main sections must be clearly separated. The main sections and sub-sections should be numbered as follows: 1, 1.1, 1.1.1.
- Numbered footnotes should be used.
- Bibliographical references must be incorporated into the text, providing the author's name and the date of publication between parentheses.

- The complete bibliographical references must be provided in alphabetical order at the end of the article. For books, indicate the author’s last name (in capitals), the initial of the author’s first name, the year of publication, the title (in italics), the place of publication, the publisher. For journal articles, indicate the author’s last name (in capitals), the initial of the author’s first name, the year of publication, the title of the article, the title of the journal (in italics), the volume number, the issue containing the article and the page numbers.

Article Admissibility Requirements

For the article to be considered by the journal, the authors must clearly demonstrate its relevance and originality in comparison to the existing specialized scientific literature on the topic. This should be presented in a document attached to the submission, summarised in three sentences. The authors may highlight aspects such as the research theme, theoretical framework, use of a specific database, sample construction, or a methodological approach involving suitable statistical or econometric tools.

For econometric studies, with replication in mind, the authors commit to providing the database used, along with any supplementary files necessary to reproduce the results.

Finally, the authors should acknowledge the limitations of their analysis (e.g., data availability, estimation techniques) that may restrict its applicability to other contexts (political, geographical, etc.) and consider potential extensions of their study.

Proofreading

The journal provides proofreading of the article. Once this step has been completed by a professional proofreader, the text is returned to the authors for validation. Upon receipt, authors are required to carefully review the article and provide their approval as soon as possible, in order to proceed with the typesetting of the article.

Proofs

The proofs will be submitted to the author for layout verification; author corrections are not allowed on the proofs.

Publication

Unless the author expressly objects, articles will be published on the website: www.cairn.info > *Revue d'économie du développement*.
